Microchips are the best way to ensure your pet is returned to you if they are lost. Fort Wayne Animal care and Control is encouraging pet owners to make sure their dogs and cats are microchipped and that the information linked to the chip is up to date. FWACC offers microchipping for just \$15. at the shelter.
