SNOWY STREETS

A significant portion of our budget is allocated for snowplowing. When there are 3 inches or more of fallen snow, a local company will be plowing streets in the neighborhood and salting the intersections. **PLEASE TRY TO HAVE YOUR VEHICLES OFF THE STREETS WHEN SNOW IS FORECAST.** It is

much easier to plow when there are no obstacles and it is less likely your car or truck will be blocked by plowed snow. Salt barrels are located at different locations throughout NGP. You will need your own shovel or scoop.

NEWS FROM THE BOARD

The New Glenwood Park annual meeting was held this past October. The 2022 budget was discussed and approved and officers were elected for 2022. Neighborhood attendance was understandingly low with covid still amongst us so here is a brief synopsis:

*Our dues for 2022 will remain at \$50/year

*The entrance sign at Desoto and Vance was repaired and the entrance sign at Trier and Rockwood was power washed.
