GARBAGE TIPS

- Set bins out by noon day before pickup
- Collect bins by noon day after pickup
- Bins must be at least 3 feet apart
- Call 311 to schedule collection of bulk items or large furniture items
 - No Freon, TVs or Toilets!
- If you place something on the curb that doesn't get picked up on a normal route, call 311, don't just leave it for next week.

NEIGHBORLY REMINDERS

- Keep your sewer grates clear of debris to prevent potential flooding
- Close garage doors to prevent thefts
- Please remember to be respectful of your neighbor's property and have your children ask permission before playing in a neighbor's yard.
